Board Resolution #3-S-2022

Resolution on Diplomate Examinee Refresher Course

WHEREAS, the Philippine Board of Orthopaedics, Inc., is the official accrediting and examining arm of the Philippine Orthopaedic Association (POA) and is tasked with helping the accredited programs upgrade the status and maintaining the quality of excellence in residency education and training in the country.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Board of Orthopaedics, Inc., in its Greenbook Manual of Policies and Procedures 4th edition 2017 page 24 under C.5.b-c and page 25 under 6.a-f detailed the guidelines for taking a six-month refresher course for training residents who failed the examinations three times.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Board of Orthopaedics, Inc., states that a candidate undergoing a refresher course should be finished before the designated date of the Diplomate Examination.

WHEREAS, an applicant named refresher course late last January 12, 2022, due to COVID surge and will end July 12, 2022, shall be accommodated to take the Diplomate Examination, July 9, 2022.

BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS NOW RESOLVED, upon careful consideration of the circumstances. The Philippine Board of Orthopaedics, Inc. will allow the applicant to take the diplomate examination provided that other requirements set forth by the PBO Examination Committee will be followed and submitted.
