# Board Resolution #7-S-2022

## **Resolution Increasing the Annual Accreditation Fees**

**WHEREAS,** The Philippine Board of Orthopaedics Inc. (PBO) is the official accrediting and examining arm of the Philippine Orthopaedic Association (POA) and is tasked with the accreditation of Training Programs in Orthopedics in the country as well as conducting PBO Diplomate Examination, the Certifying Examination in Orthopaedics.

**WHEREAS,** The Philippine Board of Orthopaedics Inc. is returning to a full face to face accreditation and examination process after the lockdown

**WHEREAS,** The Philippine Board of Orthopaedics Inc. cannot fully cover all the expenses incurred by the Trustees, its associates, and its staff in light of the increase in costs of travel as well as in the increase of training programs particularly outside Metro Manila

**BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS NOW RESOLVED** as approved by the Trustees of The Philippine Board of Orthopaedics Inc., during its Board Meeting h*eld on 30<sup>th</sup> of July 2022*, the accreditation fees per training program is set at ₱ 45,000 per annum.
