Board Resolution #1-S-2023

Resolution on Increasing the Examination Fee for Residents to take the Diplomate Examination

WHEREAS, The Philippine Board of Orthopaedics, Inc., is the official accrediting and examining arm of the Philippine Orthopaedic Association (POA) and is tasked with accreditation of Training Programs in Orthopedics in the country as well as conducting PBO Diplomate Examination, the Certifying Examination in Orthopaedics

WHEREAS, The Philippine Board of Orthopaedics, Inc., has set the schedule of the Diplomate Written, Oral Exams, and Qualifying Examinations on July 8-9, 2023 at University of Santo Tomas Hospital, España Street,

WHEREAS, The Philippine Board of Orthopaedics, Inc., Diplomate Examination Fees in the past has been P10,000.00 Pesos for the Written and Oral Examinations.

WHEREAS, there has price increase of the cost of the materials, transportation; and other expenses for the examination.

The Board of Trustees of The Philippine Board of Orthopaedics, Inc., has decided that the Examination fee will be increased to P15,000.00 Pesos, for the Written and Oral Examination, with the following conditions.

For the ones who will fail, the written and oral examinations, they need to pay again, the same amount of P15,000.00 Pesos as Examination Fee. For the ones who passed Written but failed Orals, they will pay P7,500.00 Pesos only.

If an examinee withdraws his application, for the Diplomate examination, the full amount can be refunded, only if it is done 2 weeks before the examination.

BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS NOW RESOLVED that, as approved by the Trustees of The Philippine Board of Orthopaedics, Inc., in its Board Meeting via Zoom teleconference meeting held on January 28, 2023, that the Examination fee will be P15,000.00 Pesos, for the Diplomate Examination.
