Board Resolution No. 1 – S-2025

Maximum Number of Residents per Year Level for Provisionally Accredited Training Programs

WHEREAS, the Philippine Board of Orthopaedics, Inc. [PBO] has recognized the importance of maintaining a balanced and manageable population for each year level in order to provide optimal academic support and surgical case exposure.

WHEREAS, it is essential to establish clear guidelines regarding the maximum number of residents per year level to ensure proper resource allocation, consultant supervision, and an environment conducive to academic and personal growth;

WHEREAS, provisional accreditation status of a training program requires the training institution to produce a diplomate graduate prior to being granted qualified accreditation;

WHEREAS, the maximum number of residents per year level was established upon awarding of provisional accreditation to the respective training program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the PBO hereby establishes that the training program with provisional accreditation maintains the established number of residents per year level that granted upon provisional accreditation.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the number of residents may only be increased upon achieving qualified accreditation via a written request, pending approval of the PBO.
