Board Resolution No. 2 – S - 2025

(Board resolution on the Inclusion of the Cases Done by the Level 0 Training Residents)

WHEREAS, in the duly convened regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Philippine Board of Orthopaedics, Inc. (PBO) held on March 15, 2025, in Baguio City, the Board deliberated on matters concerning the residency training requirements;

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the need to acknowledge the clinical cases managed by residents during their PBO Level 0 training as part of their learning and competency development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the Board of Trustees approves the inclusion of cases performed by residents during their PBO Level 0 training in their respective Minimum Case Requirements (MCRs), which shall be submitted to the Board as part of the requirements for the completion of their residency training program and eligibility to take the Qualifying Examination.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately and shall be disseminated to all accredited training institutions and concerned residents.
